



WAUKESHA COUNTY SMALL BUSINESS GRANTS PROGRAM

Located in Waukesha County? WWBIC is here for you! The Waukesha County Small Business Grants Program is focused on existing businesses located in Waukesha County looking for business financing during COVID-19. Villages of Chenequa, Lac La Belle and Oconomowoc Lake are not eligible.

Additional Details:

- Maximum of \$10,000.
- Grants can be used for assistance with but not limited to; payroll; rent; lease or mortgage payments; inventory for reopening; PPE for employees, clients or customers to safely reopen; or working capital.

Eligibility:

- Businesses cannot be a START-UP
- Businesses must be for-profit
- Business needs to be in good standing with State of WI
- Current on property taxes
- Business has not applied or received assistance through the Small Business Administration, Federal Emergency Management Program, or other federal government program.
- The business owner must meet the following criteria:
 1. The business is a micro business, 5 full time equivalent or fewer jobs, and the business owner's household income is under 80% of the Waukesha County Area Median.
