In May 2020, Duncan's Dog Daycare was opened in Madison. The business has an indoor and outdoor area, web cameras, small dogs separated from large dogs, and offers smaller group sizes, birthday packages, boarding services, nail trim services, enrichment activities, parking stall pick up and more.

When Samantha was first starting out and researching her idea to open the business, she attended numerous WWBIC training sessions, which then led to her applying for and getting approval for a loan to build out Duncan's Dog Daycare. A couple years later, she also received two \$5,000 grants from Associated Band and the Brewers Community Foundation.
