The Wisconsin Women’s Business Initiative Corporation (WWBIC) is a leading statewide innovative economic development corporation which supports micro-enterprise and small business in Wisconsin, as well as serving as the Veterans Business Outreach Center for Wisconsin, Illinois and Minnesota. WWBIC opens the doors of opportunity by providing anyone who is interested in starting, strengthening, or expanding a small business with access to resources such as financial products and quality business and financial wellness training.

### Credit/Financial Wellness

Improving credit and establishing good savings habits is crucial to enable Wisconsinites to achieve their financial goals. That’s why financial wellness through credit recovery and savings assistance has been one of the pillars of WWBIC’s work since 1999. In that time, WWBIC has provided **\$1.92 million in match savings** assistance! This support has resulted in the impact numbers shown at right.

### 2024 Highlights

In 2024, WWBIC served 4,603 unduplicated clients throughout the state of Wisconsin (in partnership with funders, stakeholders, and community partners). WWBIC also secured funding to open a sixth regional office in Hayward to better serve our rural communities in northern Wisconsin with training, technical assistance, and access to capital.

WWBIC also established a new record in 2024 – surpassing \$1 million in Kiva (crowd-sourced) loans over the course of the year, supporting 145 Kiva borrowers. The year closed out with a brand refresh – providing a new look while maintaining the mission of hope and opportunity that WWBIC has become known for.

### 2025 & Beyond

With the new year, change is critical. Change to not only deepen impact but define impact. To small business owners, impact means being equipped with a talented workforce, strong technology infrastructure, and the tools and resources to support their growth – particularly access to capital. WWBIC’s focus is on keeping America’s entrepreneurship engine fueled with a spark to create hope and opportunity. WWBIC thanks all of their collaborators for their continued partnership to expand economic equity by assisting micro-enterprises and small businesses throughout Wisconsin.
